Free Well Assessment!!

Southeast Rural Community Assistance Project (SERCAP) is a non-profit organization assisting rural residents and communities with water needs.

Well Assessment Includes:

- On-Site well assessment to identify the potential threats to your well, including:
 - Potential sources of well contamination, including nearby agriculture and septic systems.
 - Visual in-person inspection of your well, including inspection of proper sanitary seals, well cap screen and casing to reduce the risk of well water contamination.
 - Review of well construction relative to state standards to note any concerns.
 - Evaluation of water source to identify potential vulnerability.
 - Additional helpful information to ensure well water safety and reliability.
 - A written report of the assessment will be mailed to participants for their records.
 - Technical Assistance Providers can help recommend feasible solutions for identified issues and provide assistance to access federal and state funding for well constructions and repairs.
 - Unfortunately, at this time, we are **NOT** able to offer water sampling.
